Introduction and Background:

- ✓ Project Duration: 1st Sept. 21 to 31st August 23 (First year phase completed on 31st Aug 22)
- ✓ No. of sanctioned Nand Ghars- 400
- ✓ No. of Operational Nand Ghars- 262

Vide the reference No. VF/NG/O&M/CH/Janmitram/400NG/2021-22 dated 27th August 2021, the MOU was signed between **Vedanta Foundation Mumbai** and **Janmitram Kalyan Samiti, Raigarh** for the operation and maintenance of Nand Ghars in the districts Raipur, Bemetara, Kabirdham, Korba, Durg and Balod. The programme is based on five important verticals i.e. Education, Health, Nutrition, Community Engagement and Convergence. These verticals are successfully implemented with daily monitoring by field staffs since inception of the programme. Though, there are 400 Nand Ghars are sanctioned but currently 262 are operational. The details of existing Nand Ghars and staff deployed are given in the table below:

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The purpose of the project is to not only upgrade the infrastructure of 400 Nand Ghars but also to improve pre-school education, skill development of women and delivery of nutrition and health care in a better way. This is our eighteenth report and we are proud to proclaim that we are continuing our best to organize as many activities as we did in last 17 months. Our field staff made themselves familiar with the project activities, the concerned staff, the community and beneficiaries of the project are now well aware of the monitoring activities and it is reported that field staff are getting regular supports from the communities as well. Each month there is new energy to start with. Much like last month we continued our focus on SAM MAM children on health aspect. Survey on betterment of SAM MAM children is finished and it is found that 280 children turned their health status on growth note as most of the MAM child came into Normal category. Following table presents the highlights of the month February 2023:

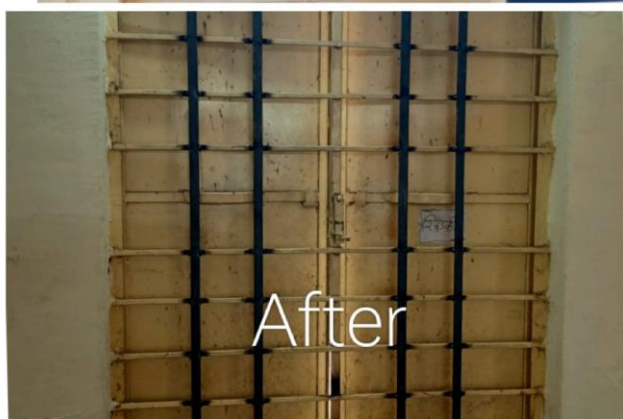

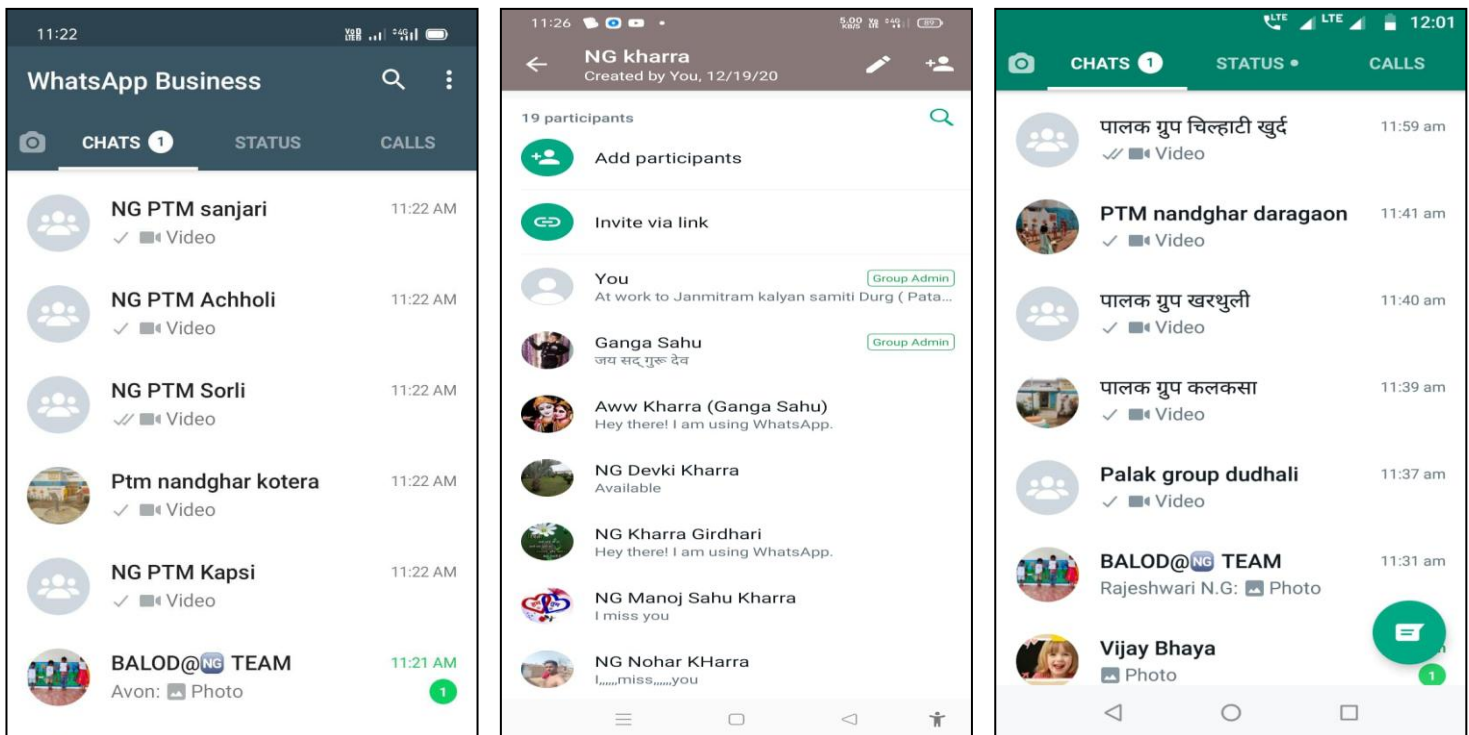
EDUCATION

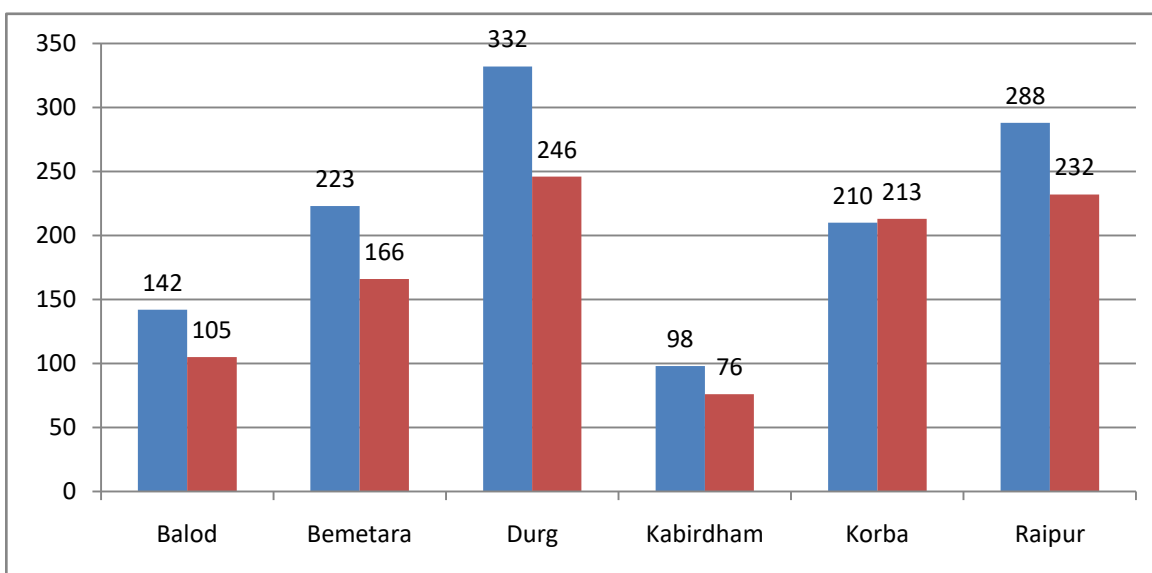
Children Growth status

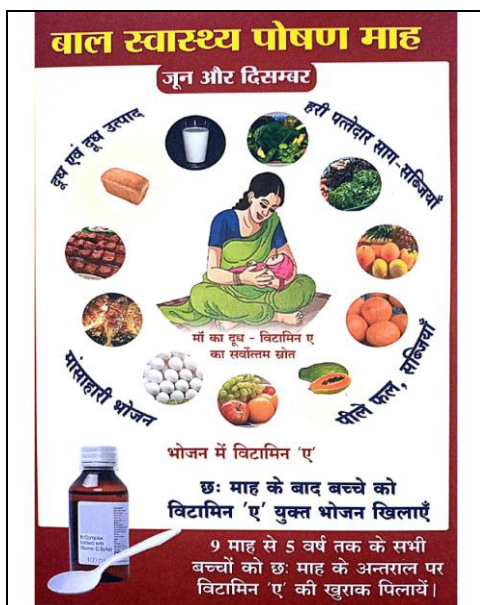

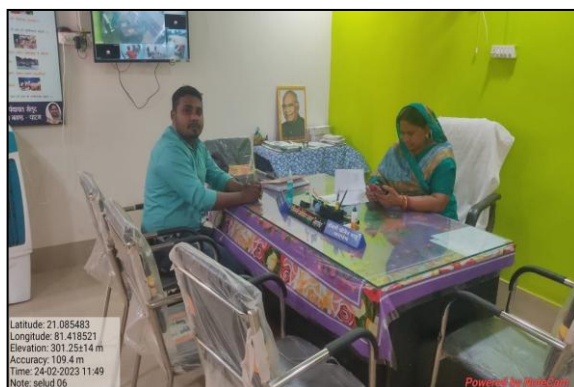

CHALLENGES:

1. To enhance qualitative work in Education, Health and Nutrition in Nand Ghars.
2. To continue good rapport with the community and convince them about the services being given in Nand Ghar for their benefit and encourage them to take the lead.
3. Convince the parents of the 0-6 year's children to send them to Nand Ghar and register them to avail the Nand Ghar services.
4. To make them understood why Nand Ghar? How it is different from the Angnawadi? What is the different between services being rendered and why it is more beneficial for them?
5. Operation of MHV in Korba and Durg is started. Regular monitoring to be followed
6. To ensure the early registration of pregnant mothers so that all the designated services may be given to them on time e.g. 3 check-ups during the pregnancy period etc.
7. To convince the community and pregnant women and their families to keep gap of at least 3 years in the birth of next child.
8. To develop 100 % kitchen garden in each and every Nand Ghar.
9. To organize successful health camp in each village of the program area.
10. To reduce the level of malnutrition in the enrolled beneficiaries of Nand Ghar.



The most challenging aspect of this programme is to keep children's health progressive. Timely nourishment in their nutrition diet is proving a good boost to improve children's growth such boosts are motivated through supports and care by PRI, our cluster coordinators, local stakeholders and authorities of higher level. A SAM child Nisha in Korba was sent to NRC Korba for more improvement in Health.



MONITORING AND EVALUATION BY ADMIN

It is always needed to counter check ongoing activities in Nand Ghars hence, following checklist were prepared and visits of programme officer was conducted in all 06 districts:

- ❖ Checking of profiled number of beneficiaries in app which should be matched by AWW record. Profiled ones should have the photo of beneficiary.
- ❖ Quality improvement in MoM.
- ❖ How to promote green belt
- ❖ Meetings with community stakeholders.
- ❖ More clarity over various heads of the programme.

Way forward and next month's plan

The improvements we have planned and will be executed from the next month are as follows:

1. **Baseline survey** and need assessment survey is completed in this month to know the exact requirements of the Nand Ghar in all the 6 districts of the project area. Analysis is ongoing.
2. **Infrastructure:** We have planned and assigned the work to all the CCs to find out how much assets items are available and how many are needed in the Nand Ghars so that demand may be put before you accordingly. Nand Ghar Committees are formed for the security of those assets.
 - To update asset register in each and every Nand Ghar.
 - To find out the possibility of convergence at each Nand Ghar.
 - Water lab testing.
 - Pest control activities.
 - To ensure food testing as per schedule at each Nand Ghar.
3. **Health & Nutrition:**
 - Collection of all the data required for the health assessment of NG children and mothers.
 - Collection of complete data for THR distribution.
 - Collection of accurate data for the vaccination/immunization of children/mothers
 - Meeting in the district Raipur, Bemetara, Kabirdham and Korba to initiate MVH services
 - Regular organization of VHSNC at planned Nand Ghars.
 - Organization of MCHN day at each Nand Ghar.
 - Organization of training of mothers for the preparation of new recipes.
 - Nourishment of existing kitchen gardens at Nand Ghar
4. **Education:**
 - To bring a sizable improvement in the enrollment at each Nand Ghar for the children
 - To keep alive the WhatsApp activities and regular interaction with the parents
 - Organization of regular WASH sessions at each Nand Ghar and encouragement for the peer support to inculcate hand wash among the children and use of sleepers when going to toilets
 - Capacity building of NG staff and organization of various training session to enhance their knowledge e.g. on early childhood education.
 - Organization of regular PTM and invite the suggestions of parents for providing better services at Nand Ghars
 - Boost the morale of NG staff to work in a better way to get rewards as we have set category and criteria for the same.
 - To ensure regular hand holding to Nand Ghar workers and Sahayika for effective delivery of ECCE as per ICDS curriculum.
5. **Community engagement:**
 - We have planned and advised our CCs to form youth groups and women's group and organize meeting with them to address community issues, expanding the reach of the program and eventually becoming the project brand ambassadors in their respective villages.
 - Award and Adherence ceremony will be conducted next quarter on the basis of most convergence done by AWW.
